Bike – Ariel plunger 1951-58

The correct rack for these bikes is a ‘W’ rack

The fitting kit is designed to mount the rack to the motorcycle and also has the provision to hold panniers should you require it.

Included in the fitting kits:-

Main fitting kit

P133	1	Bent arm front right
p135	1	L bracket
P140	1	Straight arm, rear right
P141	1	Straight leg with twist
0546	2	Bolt, ¼ CEI x 1”
S19-2Q	12	Washer, ¼”
S1-2Q	4	Nut, ¼”

Fitting the rack:- Specific notes about your kit

Main kit

Remove the lifting handle from the bike, now attach the L support stays and straight stays to the bike as per Fig 1. The original bolts can be used as the lifting handle is replaced by the support arm. Tighten up the bolts on the bike so

the support arms are in roughly the desired position. Use the two off 1 inch bolts for the lower, rear fixings. The 13/16" bolts are for the top rack fixings. Nuts and washers are also provided. Now attach the rack and tighten up nuts when the rack is in the desired position.
